

Young's intention that the colonists should go so far north as they did. It was supposed by him that the colonists would settle some where in Snake River valley, possibly in the neighborhood of the present site of Idaho Falls.

Father served four missions among the Indians on the Wind River Indian Agency and captured several hundred Indians. Records of his missionary work exist in the archives of the church as he made reports of all he did. He also served as a scout in contact with Moses Thatcher and President Lorenzo Snow one summer through the Wind River Agency and on through Yellowstone National Park. He also played an active part in the early settlement of Bear Lake County in the Dealings of the early years with the Indians, largely because of his ability to speak their language; and he was among the first to settle that valley in 1863.
